We work according to a framework of targeting the needy populations section by section, serving them and then stretching our access in order to serve the next target area and group.

OUR WORK GENDER JUSTICE VISION CREATING A GENDER JUST SOCIETY OBJECTIVE

To overcome social exclusion and injustice based on gender and bring about inclusiveness through enforcement of measures to attain gender justice that create a path for rightful enjoyment of constitutionally guaranteed rights.

VALUES

Justice: social, economic and political is a guiding principle of the constitution of India where the preamble to the constitution itself ensures its lexical priority. The irony lies in the fact that in India where women are worshipped as Shakti, the most crucial atrocities are committed against her. The degree of atrocities is magnified for women, as caste, class and gender are interlinked and deeply entrenched in the society. This is an attack on their right to live with dignity which is basic to every human being. From the cradle to grave, women are under the clutches of numerous evils acts such as discrimination, oppression, violence: within the family, at the workplaces and in the society. The root cause of all the atrocities faced by the women is (1) illiteracy,

- (2) economic dependence, (3) caste restrictions,
- (3) religious prohibition, (5) lack of leadership qualities and (6) apathetic and callous attitude of males in the society.

In this regard what is important is not only the provision of rights but that these rights should be justiciable. Proper enforcement of rights is achieved only when it is backed up by justiciable measures, redressal mechanisms. This is evident in the recent historic Sabarimala verdict where the Supreme Court of India made it clear that constitutional morality based on ideas of equality and justice is above any form of practices even if backed up by religious sentiments if it promotes any form of exclusion. But what continues to remain a gap even in this verdict is that the women's access to justice in order to realize these provisions without having to bear the brunt of the patriarchal mindset. The inclusion of women in the society requires the elimination of all forms of injustices against them as holistic development of the society cannot be achieved without complete participation of women where women constitute almost half of the society. Ambedkar, the father of Indian constitution stated: "| measure the progress of a community by the degree of progress which women have achieved". Thus, we aim to collectively work towards a gender just society that is free from the vicious cycle of poverty, social exclusion, illiteracy, violence and injustice in all forms.

We aim to achieve gender justice through an overall upliftment of women in the society through measures such as: access to education, providing public awareness on rights and justice, providing platform for voicing their opinions, grievances etc., so as to ensure that government policies and programs are in accordance with their demands, organizing discussions, seminars, conference, dialogue and other lawful gathering for promotion of capacity building, information dissemination, providing access to healthcare, helping to fight legal battles etc.

We aim at making a society where every individual is treated equally and dignity, where no rights are violated, and every grievance are heard and given due recognition.



THE IDEA OF A JUST SOCIETY A RETROSPECTIVE OF INDIAN RIGHTS AND FREEDOM

While we work for society and we look for the transformation in the society a question emerges that what do we want from society. How do we want to see our society? To understand the concept of just society or ideal society. Association for Parivartan of Nation conducted a workshop on 5th January 2019 at Hotel Sartaj, Ranchi.

Aim and objectives: To discuss the concept of Just society and what rights and responsibilities an individual hold in society. The concept of freedom and issues like human trafficking which are the barriers to a just society.

As per John Stuart Mill "Allowing individuals to live their lives as long as they didn't infringe on the rights to others, to the idea that the resources of society should be distributed to all, including those most deserving first."

Taking note from there we had a panel discussion on the idea of the just society was to know what is really meant by the term and also does it really exist? And what all constitutes a just society.

During the meeting, Mr Hassan Al Banna quotes that "when we look at the condition of distribution of resources in Jharkhand we notice that most of these are not used by the people of the state" that is why we should have to start campaigns on these issues and create awareness among the tribal.

Sneha Shah Deo talked about Human Trafficking in the state of Jharkhand and discuss the various concerns and consequences related to it.

The discussion revolved around how this inhuman activity prevails within the society and how sometimes families are responsible too. Sneha quoted "According to the National Crime Record Bureau, among the various purposes of human trafficking, trafficking for forced labour is the most prevalent, followed by prostitution (NCRB 2016)." The statistics are shocking and it's difficult to imagine things girls have to go through.

The team discussed various steps that can be taken to stop the trafficking and what roles different stakeholders can play.

The meeting started with a question that what is a just society and at the end, we can conclude that: The Association will do research on different issues in Jharkhand and present the report of the same to the Government and Media.

The main focus of work will be on Health, Education, Gender & Social Justice and Employment generation in the state of Jharkhand.

ADOPT A CHILD

Sponsorship program:



The sponsorship program is one of a kind chance to shape a moving and solid bond with a child. The sponsor sends money for the child while the child lives in his/her family and grows in their own environment. When you become a sponsor you are breaking the cycle of poverty for a child, their family and community, making an enduring and positive effect in their lives. The program is designed in a way that you can sponsor a child according to their needs. The sponsor can ideally choose that if they want to sponsor the kid fully or just some part like education. The sponsor gets all the reports from the organization about the child regarding his/her health, education and different expenses. The money funds life-changing projects in your sponsored child's community - projects that will help children access their basic rights. Which help secure the life of a child and gift a future to them and their family.

Marriage without barrier:

"I disapprove of what you say, but I will defend to the death your right to say it," said Voltaire 5.8% of Indian marriages were inter-caste, according to Census 2011, a rate unchanged over 40 years. The data clearly depicts how Inter-caste marriages are still a taboo in India and there is an urgent need for a paradigm shift in such cultures. Association for PARIVARTAN of the nation believes that there should be only one parameter for marriage which is love and consent of two people. We believe in the fundamental premise that the human individual is of primary importance in the struggle for liberation and freedom choice is of utmost importance in it.

The societal norms should not be criteria and for the same, the organization is running a campaign to spread the word on how dignity and consent are essential to dignified marriage life.

Anti- Human Trafficking Campaign:

Human trafficking is the illegal trade in human beings for the purposes of reproductive slavery, commercial sexual exploitation. The trafficker removes the fundamental human rights of the person: the opportunity to move, to pick, to control her body and mind, and to control her future. The main cause of such heinous crimes usually grow from within the family and society and it's important to curb it from the roots, therefore, the Association for PARIVARTAN of nation in the state of Jharkhand runs the awareness campaign to improve the state of Human trafficking and how the society should not indulge in the activities. Bringing change in the mindset of people and empowering the women of the state is our key to this issue. We educate girls of very small age about this issue, we educate boys to not to promote such activities and by helping them shape the future and coming generations in a way that there is not even a single case of trafficking.
